We have noticed an increasing number of reports where people with criminal intent are taking advantage of our bad habits. Here are a few simple rules that will keep you and your family safe and your property secure. Remember, when you leave yourself or your property exposed, you are creating the opportunity for a criminal to strike. Criminals look for easy targets!

Basic Rules for Home Security

- 1. Never open your outside door to a stranger...talk to them through the door.
- 2. Never let a stranger inside you house without verifying their identity.
- 3. Always keep your car locked with windows up when parked on the drive way.
- 4. Never leave items inside your parked car that someone might find attractive.
- 5. Never leave keys in your parked car, even in your garage.
- 6. Never leave kids toys outside in the front yard, especially bikes and scooters.
- 7. Never leave power tools or garden tools in front yard unless you are there working
- 8. Make a habit to keep front and back doors locked and garage door down.
- 9. When in for the evening, check this list, make sure you have done these things.
- 10. At dark, turn on front and back yard outside lights. Make sure they are working.
