Do you Oppose Building New Jail at 1901 E Grand Blvd?

The Del City. North Watch held it's second Fried Chicken Social last Friday, July 19. Members who attended got to hear our keynote speakers, Del City Mayor, Floyd Eason, State Representative, Andy. Fugate and Ward 4 Councilman, Scott Tatom. The message they presented was one of resolute opposition to building the new jail adjacent to Del City. Three times this site was voted off the list by county commissioners only to be reinstated each time by Commissioner Myles Davidson. Something appears not right. The actions of Commissioner Davidson don't pass the "sniff test." The speakers brought forward a petition to be signed. The petition would convene a grand jury to investigate the political motivation of Commissioner Davidson. For this investigation to proceed we need to collect signatures of registered voters living in Oklahoma County by July 28.
