Meeting opened with a discussion about the recently organized DCNW Leadership Council. This council is comprised of all officers of the Del City Neighborhood Watch Associations. This council will be instrumental in coordinating watches city wide efforts. The council will meet once monthly or as deemed necessary. The council will have no presiding officer, each member of the council can freely submit any issue for discussion. Lonnie Austin was elected as recorder / secretary.

The council agreed to support the formation and operation of the Del City Senior Activity Center. Our watch and Midway Village Watch has committed to support this endeavor. We will learn more at meeting with City on Aug 12.

The council has received a commitment from Del City to publish news items regarding DCNW events and accomplishments in the city wide newsletter that is published and sent to all householders with their water bill.

The Council has determined that a Recycle Program for Del City is desirable. Lonnie Austin agreed to research the available services and make report at next council meeting.

The Council has agreed that all the Patrolmen from all the watches will be encouraged to participate in a "Winky Blinky Blitz" every other month starting this month. Our Del City North Area will be covered August 30. Patrolmen will meet at the Del Crest School and drive out from there. There will be no police escort.

The E Board has approved the purchase of 6 new advertisement Banners to replace the old black and white banners we currently have post throughout the

neighborhood. The total cost will be \$237 and it will be included in our budget for next year.

We will ask if we could have a volunteer to become our Watch Photographer. We seek someone who has a camera and can attend most of our meeting and events to take pictures and post them to our Web page and make them available for the newsletter.

All our officers for this year have agreed to service another year. We will ask at the next membership meeting if anyone wants to nominate themselves or another to any officer position. In the event that happens we will have plank ballots ready. The E Board will submit to membership that they confirm the current officers for another year.

We have asked the Del City Beautification Committee to invite Ted Garrett and Troy Mize to their next meeting, WE have couple of issues we need to resolve with them. 1) a more efficient way to purchase and pay for materials to maintain the flower bed at Reno and Sooner, 2) a sign that shows Del City North Watch maintains the flower bed.

We have decided to mail our notices to all members who have not paid their dues for next year. Walter Jacques has the expertise to provide printed self adhesive address labels. Both Kay Bennett, Treasurer, and Lonnie Austin VP have address files, that can perhaps be used to make a mailing list.

We discussed forming a "Day of Service" to address critical curb appeal issues. We will ask members to consider if they would be able to support such a project? :
